## DOCK LOADING LIGHT FAN INSTRUCTIONS

ALWAYS... unplug unit for cleaning and maintenance

## DO NOT

- use an extension line other than the "V" cable included when both a fan and a light are used.
- place foreign objects through the guard into blades.
- allow the unit to become wet.
- use FAN with any solid state speed control device.

Assemble dock light with the FAN at the bottom of the arm. Attach the light to the top of the arm. The FAN requires the use of the special bolt with a shake-proof elastic stop nut both of which are included.

These replace the bolt and nut which are used to mount the light fixture when a FAN is not used.

Two 5/8" open end or adjustable wrenches will be needed to fully tighten this special bolt and elastic stop nut.

The FAN is equipped with a four position switch, which allows you to select the desired air flow. During normal operation it is not uncommon for the motor to become warm to the touch. The motor is equipped with a thermal cut-out which will automatically remove power should the motor overheat. After cooling the motor will restart. Should you notice cut-off it is a good idea to unplug (or set the switch to the off position) the FAN to avoid an unexpected restart.

Your FAN is virtually maintenance free. DO NOT oil any parts.
